Before the P-51 Mustang was introduced, American bombers flew in a box formation, relying on Flying Fortresses (and the arsenal of fire power they carried with them) for protection. With the Mustang, bombers now had a fighter escort with the speed and agility to defend against the German Luftwaffe's fighter pilots.
